In order to put The Post on the road to financial stability, we have decided to embark on a program called '1-365' that we believe will lead to sustainable financial health. The '1' stands for the part that each of us will play in this endeavor. The '365' stands for 365 people and 365 days in the year. Our goal is to find 365 people to give \$1 a day (\$365 per year or \$30 per month) to provide a sustainable foundation for the operations of The Post. This steady stream of income is vital to the ongoing work of The Post in our community. We believe that \$30 per month is within reach of many people and that our efforts to connect with 365 people will yield the critical positive outcome we seek.
